6th Grade AR Reading Expectations

AR testing is a wonderful way to personalize student's reading. It incorporates student choice in novels and a personalized reading level. Every **three** weeks, you will need to take an AR test on a 3.0-point book that is at or above your AR reading level. The reading level indicates the ability to read and comprehend words while the point value pertains to the length of a book. Books at a point value of at least three points provide a book of substance for students to read over the course of about three weeks to build comprehension stamina. <u>Tests taken on a book below a three-point value or below the student's reading level will not be accepted for an AR due date grade.</u>

Students must complete the AR comprehension test on their chosen book. If they read more than one book in the three-week timeframe and take the tests, then the highest score from the tests taken for each due date will be added to student's reading grade. The more books a student is able to complete, the more tests they will be able to take, which will provide more opportunity to ensure a higher grade. Test scores will be monitored and used as an indicator of whether the reading level needs to be adjusted. Students' list of test due dates should be kept in the reading section of their binders. **AR point values and reading levels of books need to be verified through AR Book Finder.**
